



## The Areas

AT's current areas of investment in bikeway projects are indicatively shown in yellow, and we strongly support ongoing progress and consolidation here. The green circles indicate our suggested new focus areas: some for priority from 2018 onwards, and others to be progressed as development occurs and funding allows.

With the backbone bikeways in place, we encourage AT to focus on areas rather than routes, encouraging bikeable neighbourhoods and town centres by putting the emphasis on short and medium-distance trips between residential areas, town centres, schools and public transport hubs. This would be supported by slower speed treatments and Greenways programmes.

Our suggested areas emerge from a number of factors, including existing and future housing and employment, regional cycleway projects, community initiatives to support biking culture, and support from Development Auckland and Auckland Council. Note: for reasons of space and clarity this map cannot show all desirable bikeway projects and areas. In particular, it doesn't identify all proposed Greenways projects or bikeways to be built as part of other roading works.
