A7 Cycling & Walking



The Waterview Shared Path connects communities from Waterview to Mt Roskill with a network of cycleways to destinations all over the city. Following Te Auaunga – Oakley Creek, the path is a 3.4km fun free way to local facilities, reserves, shops, parks and playgrounds. It's also a great new way to get to work, study and public transport in the area. The path links up to the newly built Southwestern Pathway and by early 2019 will link to the New Lynn to Avondale Shared Path.
